Example of Tough as Her- Tough Mudder Obstacle



The Lumber Jack Walk.

Make like a lumberjack and carry a heavy log through a section of the Tough Mudder course.

If the course is flat, **expect to be lugging your log for at least 1/2 mile**. If the area is hilly or mountainous, you'll be hauling it up a steep and challenging ascent.

Are your shoulders aching just thinking about it? But what if you had to do it every day?

Tough As Her

If you're Tough As Her you'll do it **alone** for **many miles**. To make it tougher, you'll do it <u>on an empty stomach</u>.

Wood is an indispensable fuel for many people. But finding firewood can be difficult and often includes a long journey. Once it is found, the wood must be carried back to the home.

Young girls are often forced to these types of chores for the family precluding them from being able to go to school and get a basic education that could break the cycle of poverty and hunger.

Meet Esther.

Esther is the head of one of these families. She is 32 years old and a mom to three children. She lost her husband, Simon, three years ago to the scourge of AIDS.

Two years ago, Esther got a loan through her Village Savings and Loan group. She joined when she realized that she needed to secure a better future for her children.

Every day, she and her five-year-old daughter, Amina, work in the family's garden plot. With the seeds, tools and training she received at the Village Savings and Loans group, their plot is thriving.



Esther is proud that two of her children are in school. She is able to pay the fees from the money she earns from selling the surplus of her onion crop. She hopes that Amina will go too.

But for today, Esther is thankful for the long hours she spends in the garden with Amina. The work is hard, but the time they spend together is precious. Esther knows both the value of time and the need to make the future secure for her family. She is HIV positive too.

Esther's story plays itself out every day for countless women and children in countries all over the world.

This is your chance to be tough with a purpose. To make your toughness count. At the end of the day, if you're a Tough Mudder, you'll do this for fun. If you're Tough As Her, you'll do this to live, and to make life better for your family. When we do these things we have a sense of security – we know everything will be okay.
